

Here at Atholl Court we pride ourselves on offering a large and varied selection of leaflets. They provide details on many of the Islands attractions.



We also cater for walkers and cyclists, providing colour maps, detailing various walks and rides.

Discounts are available for members of the Walk Britain scheme. Cyclists can bring their own cycles or hire them locally, and arrange delivery to us. At night your cycles are stored securely off road.

Leading from the hallway above, is our dining room where we serve breakfast. We can cater for many tastes, including vegetarians. Children also get to choose from their own menu, just like Mum and Dad.

Getting Here.



Atholl Court is located 50 yds from Shanklin Railway Station. Proceed down Atherley Road, and we are on the right.

For Wightlink Passengers.

From the Fishbourne terminal follow the A3054 to Ryde, and then the A3055 through Brading, Sandown, Lake and then into Shanklin.

From the Yarmouth terminal follow the A3054 to Newport, then the A3056 through Arreton, following the signs to Lake and then Shanklin.

For Red Funnel Passengers.

From Cowes follow the A3021 to Newport, then the A3056 through Arreton, following the signs to Lake and then Shanklin.

For Hovertravel Passengers.

Board the Island Line Train at Ryde, staying on until the last stop, which is Shanklin.

Shanklin has been a favourite for traditional seaside holidays for many years, mostly because of our award-winning beach with clean, clear water. Looking out to The English Channel across The Bay, with views extending to Culver Cliffs and Bembridge Downs.

Complimenting the beach we have the Esplanade with its Crazy Golf, Mini Golf, amusements and ample car parking. For a better view you can take the cliff side lift, which provides easy access to the cliff tops, where the views are even more spectacular.

The seafront is a real attraction for visitors to the town, with a wealth of eating establishments, pubs and the Shanklin Road Train, which also stops outside our door, providing a regular service through the summer months to the town centre and Old Village. The village is extremely pretty and most tourists head to the area for the thatched cottages, traditional village shops and old-fashioned tearooms.

Shanklin is located at the southeast corner of the Island between Sandown and Ventnor. Shanklin is the last stop for the Island Line train service, which connects to Ryde Pier Head Ferry Terminal, linking to Portsmouth, and onwards into London and the rest of the Mainland. With a regular bus service, with a stop outside Atholl Court, and the depot, which is situated by Somerfield Supermarket in Landguard Road, getting around is simple and cheap.

In the heart of The Old Village are several pubs and restaurants which are attractive, provide good food and a great atmosphere.

The shopping in Shanklin can be found in two main streets. The High Street and Regent Street. Here you can find some of the usual high street shops along with others selling a varied range of gifts for friends and family.

Once you have booked your accommodation at Atholl Court, you have entered into a legally binding contract. Atholl Court will uphold the right to levy the charges, as laid out in the Industry Standard Scale of Cancellation Charges. If for any reason you cancel your holiday in full, or are unable to stay for the complete booked period - the following charges, as detailed below, will be applied.

Notice Period is the time from initial cancellation contact with Atholl Court, to the commencement of your booking. We therefore advise all guests to have a suitable Cancellation Insurance policy in place.

Telephone reservations without credit/debit card details will be held for 7 days from the date we post the booking acknowledgement letter to you.

No allowance can be made for meals and or accommodation not taken during the booked period.

All rooms are offered subject to a £30 deposit being received per person prior to commencement of holiday.

Final balance is payable before the end of your stay. Single night bookings must be paid in full via credit/debit card at time of booking

Credit or debit card payments are to be made 3 days before the end of your holiday.
